- Consider drainage improvements to property
- Traffic calming
  - Cars racing on Union Street
  - What are the techniques?
    - Transition from 101, around the curve
    - Sidewalks
- At night need lighting
- Drainage, freezing
- Where's real estate (ROW)?
- Effect of narrowing on bikes?
- "Toll booth"
- Looking at ROW
  - Probably not widen ROW
  - Traffic calming – bumps, European techniques
  - Crosswalks
  - On street parking
- Union Mill will re-open a smaller café to address parking
- Signs: "Children"
- Flowers, looks cared for, something to look at; encourage more respectful driving
- Bike path
- Dog path
- River – access to the water
  - Canoe launch, etc.
- Light pollution
  - Look at it at night – observe lighting

- Solar-powered lights
- Info signs – hydro plant, history
- Historic signs
- Concern about runoff from new sidewalks
  - Porous pavement?
- Wilder Street – kids walk on street – danger with cars to McDowell Lake
- Wilder Street property extends to the road edge
- Pervious road pavement may become available
- Raised crosswalks downtown Wilton
- Pedestrian only crossing of Nubi River
- Pedestrian bridge from Teixeira Park to Nubi Farm periphery
  - Bridge removed 20-30 years ago - now only to island – need wetland permit.
- Plant trees e.g., near Post Office
  - Shade
  - Residential look
- Trash barrels
- Benches
- Drinking fountain
- Bike racks
- Parking for Teixeira Park
- Connect Legacy Woods with Nubi Neighborhood
- Teixeira Park not finished yet
  - Irrigation, play area
- Plantings outside stone structures
