Chair Miller called the meeting to order at 5:05pm.

**Town Meeting Presentation**

Mr. Bartlett reviewed the slides that will be presented on the evening of May 11, 2016. Chair Miller reviewed the portions of the slides and which articles she will present, as well as the Walter Peterson Medal. Mr. Bartlett reviewed that he will cover the key elements of the replacement of the Main Street Bridge, anticipating questions that might arise, sequencing for construction, as well as anticipated milestones for each phase. Mr. Runyon asked if the bridge has been deemed unsafe. Mr. Bartlett said due to age, engineering studies have deemed it limited to 15 tons weight limit, affecting fire truck accessibility and response rate. Full school buses are at the limit. Over time, the weight limit would continue to decline, as the integrity of the bridge declines.

Mr. Bartlett reviewed Articles 10 and 11, the Union Street Bridge reconstruction.

Chair Miller announced that the Walter Peterson Award will be awarded to Jim Grant on May 11<sup>th</sup> at 11:30 am as well as recognizing Jim during the Town meeting. Chair Miller also mentioned the recognition of Dr. Michael Gordon and Beth Alpaugh-Cote, and a renewable energy update, recognizing the new solar array.

Mr. Bartlett mentioned that we will be passing over Article 12.
