Chair Juengst called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm.

Non-public Session under RSA 91-A:3 II (c) (Reputation)

Letter of Support – Nashua Community College

Mr. Bartlett explained that we had a recent visit from Lucille Jordan at Nashua Community College, with the news that they are bringing a branch of the college to the Vose Farm Road complex that would include curriculum for healthcare, manufacturing, water and wastewater management. Mr. Juengst expressed that he understood that the high school may be able to connect to their curriculum. Mr. Bartlett advised that he would allow for internships and opportunities at our wastewater treatment plant, as this is a high technology manufacturing plant and this is a nationwide employment opportunity. Mr. Bartlett said the start-up date is scheduled for next fall.

Sale of Granite Street Property

Mr. Bartlett announced that the buyer for 67 Condy Rd has moved along with the home inspection, and is executing documents for completing the sale of the property.


Mr. Bartlett touched based on the tax rate breakdown for 2016. The present tax rate is \$29.71. The 2016 tax rate total comes to \$30.84, an increase of 2.77%, coming in lower than the projected increase of 2.8%. The breakdown is as follows: Municipal \$10.34, County \$1.36, Local education \$16.65, State education \$2.49 = 30.84.


