Meeting called to order by Chair at 5:35pm. Mose made motion to accept Dick Estes' letter concerning proposed parking lot behind the GAR Hall as part of tonight's meeting. Sheila seconded motion. All in favor.

Minutes of meetings November 14, 2013; December 13, 2013; January 9, 2014 accepted as corrected.

T. Ward provided an update on Scott Farrar and items of mitigation following phone contact with Eldon Munson. Tyler reported that the following items are in process: brochure of the history and walking tour guide of Peterborough; photographic display in the lobby of the new building; and reading room of Peterborough history.

T. Ward reported that he sent text for William Diamond signage to the NH Division of Historic Resources.

Tyler reported on a meeting with NH's Boston Beer Company representative and Pelagia Vincent re the William Diamond/Sam Adams commemorative brew for Peterborough's 275th Anniversary. It was suggested at this meeting that there be a local beer naming contest with first prize awarded.

A. Cadwell provided an update on the Photo Gallery project. She reported that photos for display are in progress and she is considering displaying 5 photos each side on the walls above the stairs. Members made suggestions regarding the text to accompany photo exhibit explaining the mission of Heritage Commission and our involvement with this photographic project.

T. Ward suggested that the Heritage Commission have a presence in the upcoming Visioning Forum on April 11th & 12th where Jim Grant will be showing his slide show on the History of Peterborough. Group discussion ensued and all agreed to included some of Andrea's photos. A. Cadwell recommended we use a petcha kuta presentation showing 20 photos for 20 seconds each. To be discussed again at next Commission meeting.
