Downtown Parking

Mr. Bartlett reviewed the various options which staff had researched and determined as viable projects for improving parking in the downtown. After reviewing each of the options, Mr. MacLean reviewed the results of the parking study he had conducted, noting the variance in usage based on time of day and day of the week. There followed a discussion of how to proceed, and it was determined that a Public Hearing should be held on February 25th at 7:00pm to present all the options to the public and get as much feedback as possible. The Board decided to pursue small improvements such as restriping and signage to direct drivers to underutilized all-day parking areas. There was an extended discussion about how to promote and conduct the Public Hearing.


Arts Assessment
