§ 27-1. Adoption of system.

The town adopts the Nonpartisan Ballot System for town elections, as provided for under Chapter 34 of the Revised Laws and amended by an Act of the Legislature of 1943.¹

§ 27-2. Number of petitions.

Each person filing for town officers by petition shall be required to file five (5) separate petitions.

§ 27-3. Repealer.

The vote taken at the Special Town Meeting held November 9, 1934, when the town voted to adopt the Australian Ballot System of voting for town officers, shall be rescinded.
