**§ 94-1. Application for permit; fee.**

Whoever desires to install any fuel oil burner in the Town of Peterborough shall first make application to the Chief of the Fire Department accompanied by the fee of five dollars (\$5.) and obtain a permit therefore.

**§ 94-2. Temporary permit.**

Upon receipt of an application for the installation of an oil burner, the Chief of the Fire Department shall grant a temporary permit authorizing such installation.

**§ 94-3. Permanent permit.**

Upon completion of the installation, the temporary permit shall be canceled, and provided that all rules contained in this regulation (Chapter 251, Laws of 1947, as amended, covering the installation of power oil burners and oil-burner equipment) have been complied with, the Chief of the Fire Department or his agent shall issue a permit for the storage of oil and the operation of the equipment.

**§ 94-4. Disposition of fee.**

The fee of five dollars (\$5.) shall be paid by the installer to the Town of Peterborough, four dollars (\$4.) to be paid to the inspector and one dollar (\$1.) retained by the town for handling charges.
