ARTICLE I

Materials from Power Plants

[Adopted by ATM 3-20-1979 as Art. 33]

§ 100-1. Prohibitions.

The town prohibits the transportation and storage within the town of nuclear fuel, waste products or other radioactive materials connected with nuclear-powered electric generating plants, when not preempted by state or federal statute.

§ 100-2. Violations and penalties.

Penalties for judged violations shall be assessed by the Board of Selectmen.

ARTICLE II

High-Level Waste

§ 100-3. Burial, storage, transportation and production.

The town opposes the burial, storage, transportation and production of high-level radioactive waste in the Town of Peterborough and State of New Hampshire and calls upon Congress to conduct an independent investigation with full public participation into the feasibility and prudence of the United States Department of Energy's (DOE's) present plan to dispose of radioactive waste and into the DOE's competence to carry out such a plan.
