§ 135-1 Civil Behavior

Requires all attendees of a duly noticed meeting shall act civilly. Those failing to express themselves in a civil and respectful manner will be ruled out of order.

§ 135-2 Uncivil Behavior

The following examples of uncivil behavior will not be tolerated:

- Rude and/or insulting remarks or other disrespectful behavior
- Shouting or raising of voice
- False or factually unsupported accusations
- Generally accusatory behavior
