§ 176-1. Maintenance of.

The Selectmen’s policy regarding the maintenance of designated scenic roads shall be as follows.

1. The Public Works Department shall patch and seal said roads in the usual fashion.
2. The crews shall clean existing drainage systems.
3. The crews shall cut all brush of legal size over the entire right-of-way.
4. No vegetation shall be cut at any other area of the right-of-way until such vegetation becomes dead and hazardous.
5. No improvements to any scenic road shall be made until favorable action has been received from the Planning Board.
