Minutes of the Meeting of May 8, 2014

Members agreed to postpone election of new recording secretary and possibly a new chair until meeting of June 12, 2014.

Tyler provided an update on 432 Brushbrook Road / Harris Center for Conservation Education demolition reporting that they have decided to use local contractors Schaal-Given who are amenable to considering subcontracts to Joe DeRisi, Urban Miners and a repurpose company in VT.

Update on Scott-Farrar demolition reporting that Elden is in process of negotiating with a contractor for demolition. Memorandum of Understanding was reviewed by members and Tyler Ward signed document.

Discussed next exhibit for Townhouse Gallery to run June 1 thru Aug 31. Members agreed there there was some leeway regarding putting up next show. Will discuss details with Andrea upon her return.

Mose provided an update on contact with Marcia Patten and Peter Marchand, a resource at the State Registry regarding application for National Registry reporting that the library may be ineligible due to changes in interior construction/ renovation.

Debby passed out handouts for town events. After some discussion it was agreed not pass out these fliers at upcoming Town meeting.

We discussed upcoming Town meeting and reviewed questions/concerns re GAR proposal: who will own parking lot land and impact this may have on rivers and shoreland. It was noted that \$60,000 was a high price for a feasibility study.

Motion to approve Minutes from meeting 3/13/14 and 4/10/14 approved with corrections. Debby moved; Dick seconded motion, all approved, and the motion was passed.
