Centennial Celebration

Members shared details of joint meeting of the Centennial Celebration Committee at the Monadnock Center for History & Culture with Michelle Stahl and Heritage Commission members that took place on April 7, 2018.

Peggy shared that Michelle would be providing HC members with names of merchants to approach and ask about displaying a historic photo of the building and/or streetscape. The photos are to be displayed in store windows as a "Pop Up Museum" and remain up until the fall of 2018. Discussion ensued re: suggested cost to business owner. All HC members present agreed that there should be no cost to merchant and the centennial Celebration Budget should be used to cover this cost of approximately \$35.00 per poster.

Tina Rapp shared that our next photo exhibit will include photos of Peterborough workers from the early part of the century. This exhibit will be displayed in the Town House in the fall of 2018.

Library

Members discussed Library's request for Letter to the Editor re HC support for Renovation Project. After much discussion HC decided that we would remain neutral on this topic as it is largely a financial decision to be made by people of Peterborough.

Other Business

Doug Ward reported that he met with Peterborough's new Code Enforcement Officer, Tim Herlihy and provided information re HC's Demolition Committee and their mission.

Peggy shared that Post and Beam Brewery is working hard to complete renovations and hopes to be opened by the first of June.
