Chair Ward called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

**Discuss Article 22 and Vote on appropriation of \$750,000 for the establishment of the Ambulance Revolving Fund**

Mr. Bartlett explained that the Department of Revenue and Administration had issues with the way Article 9 was written, the article was first broken into Article 9a and 9b. Article 9a is now Article 21 and Article 9b is now Article 22. Article 21 has no money associated. Article 22 has an appropriation of \$750K to be deposited into a revolving fund, the monies that were previously in the special revenue account. With dissolution of the special revenue account, Article 22 proposes to establish a new revolving fund.

Mr. Clark asked why the change from an operating special fund to a revolving fund. Mr. Walker responded that a revolving fund allows spending with Select Board approval as opposed to Town Meeting approval. He used the example of when the ambulance monitors were replaced. With the revolving fund, the department can expend money that is in the fund, to meet specific needs when the need arises.

Mr. Patten expressed that the Recreation Revolving fund has been effective.

*Motion:* Mr. Patten made a motion to approve the Appropriation of \$750,000 for the establishment of the Ambulance Revolving Fund.


*Vote:* Mr. Hanson seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.
